

TERMS & CONDITIONS



- ♣ Entry Fees must be paid before or on the day.
- ♣ All Crew Must be Registered to receive any Prizes.
- ♣ Multiple entries of the same fish are NOT permitted by either the same or multiple persons
Commercial Boats must have proof of de registration All entrants boat owners, spectators participate at their own risk. The organisers, promoters or any party connected with the event accept absolutely no responsibility in any respect for personal injury, loss or damage to property regardless of the cause
- ♣ All prize-winning anglers must attend prizegiving to receive their prize. Any prize-winning anglers not in attendance will forfeit their prize
- ♣ Each boat must carry at least the minimum safety equipment; it is essential that all boats carry a VHF radio or cell & life jackets must be worn
- ♣ The competition is held in the spirit of amateur fishing and fair competition. If in the opinion of the organising committee competitors have breached the spirit of the competition, then the committee reserves the right to exclude the competitor. The committee's decision will be final.
- ♣ **All fish to be gutted and cleaned before weigh in – ICE YOUR CATCH**
- ♣ **Weigh in Friday 12pm till 3pm & Saturday 10am final cut off 3pm at the Pohara Boat Club**
- ♣ **Catch limit 2 per species per person per day.**
- ♣ Children must carry their own catch to the weigh station
- ♣ Species category's Blue Cod, Gurnard, Terakihi, Kahawai, Kingfish, Snapper, Other
- ♣ You Must - "Trunking" a "grey boy" shark (also known as a **school shark** or **tope shark**) refers to a specific method of processing the fish immediately after landing it to ensure edibility or it will not be excepted
- ♣ **Prize Giving starts approx. 5 pm on Saturday 7th February 2026**
- ♣ **Registered before 5.00pm on Thursday 5th February 2026 or on the day**
